

POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS (2019)

- The Tigné Point Pool opening times are from Monday to Sunday, from 9:00AM to 7:00PM.
- Requests for early entry can be made directly to MIDI (adult swimmers only).
- The pool is open **ONLY** to members in possession of a valid membership card or guest card.
- Residents of Tigné Point (including owner-occupiers and long term tenants), **including their direct ascendants and descendants** are eligible for application of a pool membership.
- The membership card must be shown at the pool reception desk prior to entering the pool area. In the event that members fail to produce their membership card, entry will not be granted to the pool.
- All membership cards are personalized and non-transferrable (also not against a fee). Membership cards are to be used by the person named on the card **ONLY**. MIDI reserves the right to request photo identification.
- Guest Cards can **ONLY** be purchased by host members.
- In order to be eligible to purchase a Guest Card a General Entry Card must first be purchased by the host member.
- Holders of Guest Cards are allowed to enter the premises without the host member.
- Guest Cards are to be validated by the Pool Operator on every visit.
- A maximum of (4) guests per Guest Card are allowed in to the pool at any one time.

- **Children under twelve (12) years are to be accompanied and supervised by an adult in possession of a valid pool card at all times.**
- **Toddlers under two (2) years old are NOT allowed in the adult pool (even if accompanied) and those under three (3) are to wear swim-diapers.**
- **Children under fourteen (14) years using the wading pool (children's pool) must be accompanied by an adult.**
- **No running or horseplay is allowed on the deck areas.**
- **No diving is allowed in the pools.**
- **Toys, balls, inflatable toys and rafts are NOT PERMITTED in the adult pool. Buoyancy aids are permitted.**
- **Noise levels are to be kept to a minimum at all times - especially between the hours of 2:00pm and 4:00pm.**
- **No parties are to be organised within the facility without the express written consent of MIDI.**
- **Headphones must be worn when listening to musical or entertainment devices.**
- **Patrons who have suntan lotions or body creams on are to shower before using the pool.**
- **Appropriate swimwear / clothing is to be worn at all times. No topless / nude bathing is permitted.**
- **Any member caught abusing of the facilities and / or equipment will be asked to pay for damages.**
- **Persons who have an ear infection or a communicable condition or disease must not use the pools.**

- Do not wear eye-glasses in the pools unless necessary. Non-breakable lenses and frames are necessary for safety.
 - No glassware is to be taken into the pool.
 - No pets are to be brought into the pool complex.
 - No food, drinks, deck-chairs, sun-beds or beach umbrellas are to be brought into the facility. Food orders are only permitted from the authorised pool kiosk operator.
 - MIDI plc or its operators / managers shall not be liable for any loss or theft that may occur in or on facilities.
 - MIDI plc or its operators / managers do not accept responsibility for injury or damage.
 - Members are to follow any reasonable directions which may be given to them for reasons of health and safety, access restrictions or works in the vicinity.
 - Management reserves the right to terminate or revoke membership in case of repeated breaking of the rules described above.
 - Host members are fully liable for any damage or disruption caused by their Guest Card holders.
 - Although lifesaving equipment is in place **THE POOL IS NOT MANNED BY A LIFE-GUARD.**
